NOTICE INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI).

MSME-Development Institute, Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India, intends to conduct Two (02) nos. of one-day Awareness Workshops on Energy Efficient Technology with MSME Clusters/ Units in the month of February/ March, 2017. These programmes have to be conducted through expert organization(s) like PCRA, BEE, TERI, IITs, NITs etc. or State Government Agencies, like MITCON, GEDA etc. besides the autonomous bodies of Central/ State Governments.

The main objective of such programme is to sensitize the MSMEs of West Bengal to upgrade their manufacturing processes towards usage of Energy Efficient Technologies (EET) so as to reduce the cost of production and emission of Green House Gases (GHG).

After the Awareness Workshops, Organizations have to follow up MSMEs as Cluster units as well as individuals for adopting the energy efficient technologies with the help of O/o DC, MSME, Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India, Grants & Subsidies schemes. After the programme, interested MSEs may submit their names for energy audit and preparation of DPR for recommendation of energy efficient technology.

The interested organizations may send their offer for desired EOI (as per attached format) to the Director, MSME-DI, Kolkata, within Seven (07) days from the date of issue.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST OF EXPERT AGENCIES TO CONDUCT AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON ENERGY EFFICIENT TECHNOLOGIES ETC UNDER TEQUP OF NMCP SCHEME OF MINISTRY OF MSME, GOVT. OF INDIA

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this date between the DIRECTOR, MSME-DI, Kolkata, Ministry of Micro & Small Scale Industries, Government of India, [“the Government”] having its principal place of business at 111 & 112, B. T. Road, MSME-DI, Kolkata – 700 108, and [-----] (“the Organization”) having its principal office located at ----- (Insert Organization's Name) (Insert Organization's Address)

WHEREAS, “the Government” wishes to have the Organization the Assignment hereinafter referred to, and WHEREAS, “the Organization” is willing to perform this Assignment,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES hereby agree as follows:

I. SERVICE: “The Organization” shall conduct the one day awareness programmes (comprising of around 30 MSME participants) in selected MSME cluster as selected by “the Government” on the following topic:

- (a) Energy Efficient Technologies;
- (b) Availability of Energy Efficient Equipments; and
- (c) The need for energy efficiency and cash benefits from Energy Efficient Technologies (EFT) and Clean Development Mechanism (CDM)

The scope of conducting the Awareness Programme is contained in the Technology and Quality Upgradation Support (TEQUP), a component of National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme. The details of this TEQUP component is available in public domain i.e. <http://dcmsme.gov.in/schemes/technology&quality10.pdf>.

2. EXPENDITURE & PAYMENT: Towards organizing the awareness programme, the Government of India will provide financial support to the extent of 75% of the actual expenditure subject to maximum ` 75,000 per programme on reimbursement basis as per provision of GFR-2005 of Govt. of India. The balance amount is to be contributed by the participants, Cluster associations etc. The Government grant shall be utilized towards meeting the expenditure on technical inputs from faculties/experts and their course material, travel and lodging expenses, other miscellaneous expenses, etc.

3. TERMS & CONDITIONS: “The Organization” shall perform the Assignment [within 1 month from the date of this Agreement] or any other period as may be subsequently agreed by the parties in writing. “The Organization” undertakes to perform the Assignment with the highest standards of professional and ethical competence and integrity and ensure that the expenditure incurred for conducting the awareness programme and reimbursement thereof will adhere compliance of GFR-2005.

4. OWNERSHIP OF MATERIAL:

Any studies, reports or other material, graphic, software or otherwise, prepared by "the Organization" for "the Government" under the Agreement shall belong to and remain the property of the Government. "The Organization" may retain a copy of such documents and software for the purpose of this Agreement.

5. OUTCOME OF THE AWARENESS PROGRAMME: On completion of the Awareness programme, remaining part of Activity-1 of TEQUP may be expected to initiate at the above selected cluster as per guideline of the scheme as follows:

- (1) Supporting energy audits to be conducted in sample units (3 Nos. in each cluster representing the micro, small and medium enterprises respectively) in energy intensive clusters. The related activities will be identification of energy efficient technologies for typical production units and preparation of model Detailed Project Report (DPRs) for cost effective, bankable energy efficient projects. The recommendations in the model DPRs will be used with the cluster based MSMEs for demonstrating the scope, need and financial benefits from EET projects.
- (2) Promoting replication of model EET projects in the cluster based MSMEs and subsidizing the preparation cost of the DPRs for the EET projects taken up by the individual MSMEs.
